EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Renz & Associates, Inc. was retained by Homer Homes 1 LLC to perform a Phase I Environmental Assessment (ESA) of the Elk Landing Mobile Home Community located at 1100 S Randall Avenue in Elk City, Oklahoma (Figures 1 and 2). The property is identified by the Beckham County Auditor as parcel 0425-28-011-021-0-002-00 and is about 20.33 acres in area. The Phase I Environmental Assessment was performed as part of a due diligence effort during February of 2026. A Phase I Environmental Assessment was previously performed on the property by Renz & Associates, Inc. in 2015. The study concluded that no Recognized Environmental Conditions were present and no further investigation was recommended.

The purpose of this project was to perform "*All Appropriate Inquiry*" regarding the presence or potential presence of hazardous wastes or fugitive liquid petroleum substances to establish the "*Innocent Purchaser Defense*" as defined under 42 USC § 9607 (b)(3) of the Superfund Amendment and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA).

The property consists of a mobile home park located approximately one mile southwest of the center of the Elk City (Figure 2). The park has around 120 home sites and is divided up by asphalt paved access roads. The park is served by the municipal water supply and wastewater treatment systems. The home sites also have access to natural gas, electrical power and telecommunication services. Photographs of the property are presented as Appendix A.

The property is located in an area which has been under going conversion from agricultural land to residential use over the past 60 years. The predominantly residential with scattered commercial properties along main roads with few light industrial operations. The mobile home park is adjoined on the north by West 11th Street and single family homes beyond, on the west by South Randall Street and an equestrian facility and pastures beyond, the south by a single family home and a rail line and one the west by South Slate Avenue and single family homes (Figure 2).

A summary of the findings are presented below:

- **Historical Review**

Previous land used was determined using historical aerial photographs, Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps and topographic maps. No date of construction could be found in online county records, but historical aerial photographs shoe the property as an agricultural field in 1965 and the northeast portion of the park developed in an image from 1972. By 1984 the park was fully developed. The property has been used exclusively as a mobile home park since its development. No environmentally significant changes have taken place on the adjoining properties.

- **Regulatory Review**

Four listing of sewage spills on the property were found. The spills took place between 2013 and 2022. The spills were actually leaks from sanitary lines under mobile homes. These listings are not Recognized Environmental Conditions.

A leaking underground storage tank was previously located at 1101 S. Randall Avenue at the Beckham County Engineers facility. The leak apparently only impacted soil immediately around the tank and was remediated. This listing is not a Recognized Environmental Conditions.

A listing for a solid waste recycling facility was found for a property located within 0.25 miles. Due to the nature of recycling facilities, this listing is not a Recognized Environmental Conditions.

- **Wetlands and Flood ways**

The National Wetland Inventory of the US Department of Fish and Wildlife indicates that no wetlands are present on the property. FEMA flood insurance maps show that the property lays outside of any know flood zone.

- **Vapor Encroachment Potential**

In accordance with ASTM 1527-21, Renz & Associates, Inc. performed a vapor encroachment screening to evaluate the potential for gas phase chemicals of concern to be present in the subsurface of the park. The screen involves identifying potential sources of petroleum or volatile organic chemicals which may have been released into the soils near the subject property. The search radius for sources of petroleum is 0.10 miles and 0.33 miles for volatile organic compounds. No leaking tank sites or facilities which have released volatile organic compounds lay within the specified distances.

- **Site Inspection**

An inspection of the subject property was conducted by a representative of Renz & Associates, Inc. on December 8, 2026. The purpose of the inspection was to visually assess the site and identify any recognizable environmental concerns. The visibility of the land surface was unobstructed at the time of the inspection. The land was found to be free of any staining, stressed vegetation, excavations, soil piles or other conditions suggestive of contamination. The adjoining properties were viewed from the boundary of the subject property. No evidence of underground storage tanks, pits or lagoons, evidence of buried wastes or burning of chemical wastes was observed on the adjoining properties. Photographs taken during the inspection are presented in Appendix A.

Interviews were conducted with the owner, a current resident, an individual who identified themselves as a long time local resident who has been personally familiar with the property for over 50 years and a member of the Elk City Police Department. The following was reported during interviews:

- The site has been used as a mobile home park since the early 1970s and was previously farmland.
- No methamphetamine laboratories are known to have ever been on the property.
- No bulk quantities of chemicals, solvents or fuels are known to have been stored on the property.
- No underground storage tanks are known to have been located on the property.
- A previous environmental assessment was performed on the property in 2015.

- **Conclusions & Recommendations**

The results of the Phase I Environmental Assessment revealed No “*Recognized Environmental Concerns*”. No further investigation is recommended at this time.

The conclusions and recommendations presented are based upon the level of effort and investigative techniques using a degree of care and skill ordinarily exercised under similar conditions by reputable and qualified professionals practicing in the same or similar locality at the time of service. 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1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background and Previous Investigations

Renz & Associates, Inc. was retained by Homer Homes 1 LLC to perform a Phase I Environmental Assessment (ESA) of the Queen City Mobile Home Community located at 1100 S Randall Avenue in Elk City, Oklahoma (Figures 1 and 2). The property is identified by the Beckham County Auditor as parcel 0425-28-011-021-0-002-00 and is about 20.33 acres in area. The Phase I Environmental Assessment was performed as part of a due diligence effort during February of 2026.

A Phase I Environmental Assessment was previously performed on the property by Renz & Associates, Inc. in 2015. The study concluded that no Recognized Environmental Conditions were present and no further investigation was recommended.

1.2 Purpose and Scope of the Assessment

The purpose of this project was to perform "*All Appropriate Inquiry*" regarding the presence or potential presence of hazardous wastes or fugitive liquid petroleum substances to establish the "*Innocent Purchaser Defense*" as defined under 42 USC § 9607 (b)(3) of the Superfund Amendment and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA).

The scope of the investigation included identifying the following types of facilities located within the minimum search distances established under ASTM Standard Procedure E 1527-05, entitled "*Environmental Site Assessments: Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Process*."

- Solid and hazardous waste treatment, storage and/or disposal (TSD) facilities.
- Sites recognized by state and/or federal agencies to be associated with uncontrolled releases of regulated hazardous substances or liquid petroleum products.
- Sites containing underground storage tanks regulated by state and/or federal programs.

The scope of the study also included reviewing historic land uses through a review of Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps, if available and property title records on file with the County Recorder's office.

1.3 Property Description

The property consists of a mobile home park located approximately one mile southwest of the center of the Elk City (Figure 2). The park has around 120 home sites and is divided up by asphalt paved access roads. The park is served by the municipal water supply and wastewater treatment systems. The home sites also have access to natural gas, electrical power and telecommunication services. Photographs of the property are presented as Appendix A.

1.4 Investigation Methodology

The scope of the Phase I Environmental Site Assessment encompassed a visual inspection of the site and surrounding properties, the identification of regulated and unregulated hazardous waste sites and registered underground storage tanks within minimum search distances defined by ASTM Standard Procedure E 1527-21, and the research and review of publicly accessible records. The ASTM minimum search distances used for this study are as follows:

A database search was conducted by a commercial geographic information systems (GIS) firm, for the types of facilities listed above. The research area used by EDR was one mile from the project site and is illustrated by the search area map included in the EDR report in Appendix D -*EDR Database Search Results*. The EDR research included those state and federal databases listed in Table 1. Copies of the EDR database report and property records are presented as appendices to this report.

2.0 PHYSICAL SETTING

2.1 Site and Surrounding Area Land Use

The property is located in an area which has been under going conversion from agricultural land to residential use over the past 60 years. The predominantly residential with scattered commercial properties along main roads with few light industrial operations. The mobile home park is adjoined on the north by West 11th Street and single family homes beyond, on the west by South Randall Street and an equestrian facility and pastures beyond, the south by a single family home and a rail line and one the west by South Slate Avenue and single family homes (Figure 2).

2.2 Flood Insurance Rate Map

Review of the Flood Insurance Rate Map FM4000100018D , published by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and dated December 16, 2003 indicates that the property lays partially within a special flooding hazard zone. A copy of the map is presented in Appendix B.

2.3 Regional Geology and Hydrology

The site is situated within Interior Lowlands physiographic province. This physiographic setting is characterized by level terrain dissected by streams. The elevation of the area ranges between approximately 2,300 feet above mean sea level (MSL) along interfluviate ridges and 1800 MSL along stream courses. The subject property is at an elevation of approximately 1,960 MSL (Figure 1). Elevations generally decrease to the southeast, towards the Red River.

Bedrock in the area consists of shales with lenses of shale and gypsum belonging to the Quartermaster formation. The depth to bedrock is very shallow ranging 15 feet to being exposed at grade along stream beds and ridge tops. The bedrock is approximately three feet below grade on the property.

The subject property is located on the upper flanks of the Elk Creek stream valley. The stream channel is located approximately one mile to the east of study site.

The depth to ground water varies through out the area, ranging from less than 10 feet in unconsolidated deposits along stream valleys to up to 140 feet in the bedrock in upland areas. The depth to ground water in the area of the site is unknown, but is likely on the order of 50 to 100 feet in bedrock.

3.0 HISTORICAL REVIEW

3.1 Property History

Previous land used was determined using historical aerial photographs, Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps and topographic maps. No date of construction could be found in online county records, but historical aerial photographs show the property as an agricultural field in 1965 and the northeast portion of the park developed in an image from 1972. By 1984 the park was fully developed. The property has been used exclusively as a mobile home park since its development. No environmentally significant changes have taken place on the adjoining properties.

3.2 Aerial Photography Interpretation

Historical aerial photographs for the Subject Property and surrounding areas were reviewed for the years 1965, 1972, 1984, 1995, 2005, 2006, 2008 and 2010. The 1965 image shows the property as an agricultural field. The 1972 photograph shows the five rows of mobile homes from West 11th Street on the north down to West 14th Street. The remaining portion of the property is undeveloped. The 1984 image shows the park fully developed. The adjoining properties appear as they do today. The images from 1995 through 2010 show the park as it appears today. Little change took place in the surrounding area through the sequence. Copies of the photographs are presented in Appendix C.

3.3 Historic Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps and Topographic Maps

A search for historic Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps for the study area was conducted. No Sanborn maps were found as the property was agricultural fields at the time that the production of the map ceased.

Historic USGS topographic maps for the years 1987, 2010 and 2016 were found. The maps show the park present but only the roads are plotted. No buildings are present on the property. No environmentally significant features are plotted on the adjoining properties. Copies of the maps are presented in Appendix C.

3.4 Historic City Directory Listings

No historic city directories listings were found for the subject property.

3.5 National Registry of Historic Places

An electronic search of the National Registry of Historic Places was made on February 3, 2026 for the subject properties. No listing was found.

3.6 Known Archeological Sites

The Oklahoma Historical Society was contacted to determine if the study location was a known archeological site. At this time, the site is not known to have archeological artifacts present.

4.0 REGULATORY REVIEW

A search was conducted by EDR for regulated and unregulated solid and hazardous waste facilities and registered underground storage tanks located within one mile of the study site. A summary of the EDR report is included as Appendix D -*EDR Database Search Results*.

Renz & Associates, Inc. visually searched a 0.25 mile site radius in order to identify any facilities not identified in the EDR report. No indications of solid or hazardous waste sites or regulated USTs not identified by the EDR database search were found. A list-by-list summary of the EDR information is presented below.

4.1 National Priorities List (NPL)

The National Priorities List (NPL), also known as the Superfund List, is the US Environmental Protection Agency's database of uncontrolled or abandoned hazardous waste sites. These sites are targeted for possible long term remedial action under the Superfund Act. The ASTM area of concern for NPL includes all properties within one mile of the subject site. The search identified no NPL sites.

4.2 CERCLIS List

CERCLIS is a comprehensive listing of known or suspected uncontrolled or abandoned hazardous waste sites. These sites have either been investigated or are undergoing investigation by the US EPA for a release or threatened release of hazardous substances, pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA). The ASTM area of concern for CERCLA includes all properties within one half mile of the subject site. No CERCLA sites were identified within a one half mile radius of the study site.

4.3 RCRA

The US EPA's Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) program identifies and tracks hazardous wastes from their place of generation to their final disposal. The *RCRA Facilities Database* is a compilation by the EPA of reporting facilities which generate, transport, treat, store or dispose of hazardous wastes. Presented below is a summary of the search results for RCRA facilities located within the prescribed distances from the subject property.

RCRA-LQG This report contains information pertaining to Large Quantity Generators which either generate more than 1,000 kg of hazardous waste per month or meet other applicable requirements under RCRA. The ASTM area of concern for Large Quantity Generators includes only the subject site and adjoining properties. No Large Quantity Generators are identified within the ASTM recommended area of concern.

RCRA-SQG This report contains information pertaining to Small Quantity Generators which either generate between 100 and 1,000 kg of hazardous waste per month or meet other applicable requirements under RCRA. The ASTM area of concern for Small Quantity Generators includes only the subject site and adjoining properties. No Small Quantity Generators are identified within the ASTM recommended area of concern. One SQG was identified approximately 0.13 miles from the property. The facility has no reported releases. This listing is not a Recognized Environmental Condition.

RCRA TSD: This report contains information pertaining to facilities which treat, store or dispose of hazardous waste. The ASTM area of concern for TSD facilities includes all properties within one mile of the subject site. No TSD facilities are shown within the ASTM recommended area of concern.

4.4 Emergency Response Notification System (ERNS)

The Emergency Response Notification System (ERNS) is a national computer database system used to collect information on sudden and/or accidental releases of hazardous substances and petroleum into the environment. The database contains information from spill reports made to federal authorities including the US EPA, the US Coast Guard, the National Response Center, and the Department of Transportation. The ASTM area of concern for ERNS notifications includes only the subject site. The site is not listed under the ERNS program.

4.5 State Priority List

The State Priority List (SPL) is a generic name for state databases that contain sites considered to be actually or potentially contaminated, and that present a potential threat to human health and/or the environment. Lists are generally maintained by each individual state to warn the public, or as a part of an investigation and cleanup program managed by the state. The ASTM area of concern for SPL sites includes all properties within a one mile radius of the subject site. No SPL sites were identified

4.6 Licensed Solid Waste Facilities

A database is maintained by the US EPA, *Division of Solid and Infectious Waste* of licensed solid waste facilities, including solid waste landfills, incinerators, and transfer stations. The ASTM area of concern for Licensed Solid Waste Facilities includes all properties within a half mile of the subject site. The EDR database search did not identify any solid waste facilities within one half mile of the study site. A solid waste recycling facility was identified approximately 0.17 miles from the park. This listing is not a Recognized Environmental Condition.

4.7 Registered Underground Storage Tanks

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission maintains a database of registered underground storage tanks (USTs) for each county of the state. Underground storage tanks containing heating fuels for consumptive use on site, as well as farm or residential USTs of 1,100 gallons or less capacity used for storing motor fuel for noncommercial purposes are exempt from registration requirements.

The ASTM recommended search distance for registered underground storage tanks specifies the project site and adjoining properties. No underground storage tanks were identified on the subject or adjoining properties. Four underground storage tanks were located 0.037 miles to the southeast at 1101 South Randall Avenue at the Beckham County Engineers District 2 maintenance facility but were removed.

4.8 Petroleum Underground Storage Tank (LUST) Release Incidents

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission maintains a database of leaking underground storage tank (LUST) incidents for the state. The ASTM minimum search distance for LUST sites includes all properties within a half mile of the subject site. One listings for a LUST site within one half mile was found found:

- Beckham County Engineers District 2, 1101 South Randall Avenue 0.037 miles SE

A release was suspect, but determined not to have actually occurred and the case was closed in 2008. This listing is not a Recognized Environmental Condition.

4.9 Spill Reports

Releases of hazardous wastes are tracked by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality. The department is responsible for tracking and overseeing spill and other types of release of hazardous materials and wastes from both regulated and non-regulated facilities. The agency provides a list of releases occurring within the area identified in the request.

No spills of hazardous wastes or petroleum were recorded for the property. Four minor spills of sewage were reported between 2013 and 2020. The spills were due to leaks in the connection between several mobile homes and the sanitary system. These listings are not a Recognized Environmental Condition.

4.10 Clandestine Methamphetamine Laboratories

The US Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) maintains a national registry which contains addresses of some locations where law enforcement agencies reported they found chemicals or other items that indicated the presence of either clandestine drug laboratories or dump sites. In most cases, the source of the entries is not the DEA, but rather local law enforcement. Therefore, the DEA has not verified the entry and does not guarantee its accuracy. The registry currently contains no listing for the subject property.

5.0 SITE INVESTIGATION

5.1 Site Inspection

An inspection of the subject property was conducted by a representative of Renz & Associates, Inc. on December 8, 2026. The purpose of the inspection was to visually assess the site and identify any recognizable environmental concerns. The visibility of the land surface was unobstructed at the time of the inspection. The land was found to be free of any staining, stressed vegetation, excavations, soil piles or other conditions suggestive of contamination.

The adjoining properties were viewed from the boundary of the subject property. No evidence of underground storage tanks, pits or lagoons, evidence of buried wastes or burning of chemical wastes was observed on the adjoining properties. Photographs taken during the inspection are presented in Appendix A.

5.2 Interviews

Interviews were conducted with the owner, a current resident, an individual who identified themselves as a long time local resident who has been personally familiar with the property for over 50 years and a member of the Elk City Police Department. The following was reported during interviews:

- The site has been used as a mobile home park since the early 1970s and was previously farmland.
- No methamphetamine laboratories are known to have ever been on the property.
- No bulk quantities of chemicals, solvents or fuels are known to have been stored on the property.
- No underground storage tanks are known to have been located on the property.
- A previous environmental assessment was performed on the property in 2015.

6.0 OTHER RESEARCHED CONDITIONS

6.1 Polychlorinated Biphenyls

Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) are commonly associated with oils contained in older electrical transformers and capacitors. In Phase I assessments, these units are considered to be of concern when they are in disrepair or are leaking. PCBs are not considered a potential environmental hazard on the subject site.

6.2 Asbestos

The term asbestos is given to a group of naturally occurring fibrous, inorganic, hydrated mineral silicates. The asbestos group includes actinolite, amosite, anthophyllite, chrysolite and crocidolite. Prior to 1980, asbestos was widely used in the construction of fireproofing, insulation and soundproofing; it is still being used in a diminished capacity. No asbestos survey was conducted.

6.3 Radon

Radon-222 (^{222}Rn), the nation's largest source of background radiation, is a colorless, odorless gas which originates from the decay of Uranium-238 (^{238}U). The current EPA standard for radon is 4 pCi/l. The normal outdoor level is approximately 0.5 pCi/l.

According to the US EPA, the site is located in an area rated Radon Zone Level 3, which has a predicted average indoor screening level of less than 2 pCi/L. However, the actual concentration of Radon which will accumulate in any proposed structure will depend heavily on such factors as building construction, ventilation and size. The EPA's Office of Radiation and Indoor Air recommends that buildings be tested for Radon regardless of geographic location or the property's zone designation. Furthermore, Radon is not currently subject to federal, state or local regulations.

6.4 Wetlands

The National Wetlands Inventory maintained by the US Department of Fish and Wildlife shows no wetlands on the property. No wetland land evaluation of the property was made, however the National Wetlands Inventory map shows no wetlands on the subject property. A copy of the National Wetlands Inventory Map for the site is presented in Appendix C.

6.5 Endangered Species and Unique Habitats

The Oklahoma City Field Office of the US Fish & Wildlife Service was contacted to determine if the study site was known to contain habitats of rare and endangered plants, animals and natural communities. It was reported that no rare and endangered plants, animals and natural communities were listed for the subject site.

6.6 Vapor Encroachment Potential

In accordance with ASTM 1527-21, Renz & Associates, Inc. performed a vapor encroachment screening to evaluate the potential for gas phase chemicals of concern to be present in the subsurface of the property. The screen involves identifying potential sources of petroleum or volatile organic chemicals which may have been released into the soils near the subject property. The search radius for sources of petroleum is 0.10 miles and 0.33 miles for volatile organic compounds. No sources of vapors were identified within the search radii.

7.0 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The purpose of this Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) was to identify, to the extent feasible, any *recognized environmental conditions* which might be associated with the site in its present condition. *Recognized environmental conditions* are defined as the presence or likely presence of hazardous substances or petroleum products under conditions that indicate an existing release, a past release, or a material threat of a release of hazardous substances or petroleum products into structures on the property or into the ground, ground water or surface water of the property. Phase I ESAs, in conjunction with Phase II and III assessments, are intended to permit a user to satisfy one of the requirements needed to qualify for the *innocent landowner defense* to CERCLA liability; that is, practices that constitute "all appropriate inquiry into previous ownership and uses of the property consistent with good commercial or customary practice" as defined in 42 USC §96001 (35) (B). Furthermore, it was the objective of this study to determine if the site was the location of any buildings on the National Registry of Historic Places and to determine if it was currently a known archeological site.

7.1 Conclusions

The results of the Phase I Environmental Assessment revealed No "*Recognized Environmental Concerns*".

7.2 Significant Data Gaps

No significant data gaps were encountered in the study.

7.3 Limitations

The conclusions and recommendations presented are based upon the level of effort and investigative techniques using a degree of care and skill ordinarily exercised under similar conditions by reputable and qualified professionals practicing in the same or similar locality at the time of service. No other warranty, expressed or implied, is made by this report.

Conclusions presented by Renz & Associates, Inc. are consistent with the Scope of Work, level of effort specified and investigative techniques employed. 7.4 Certification

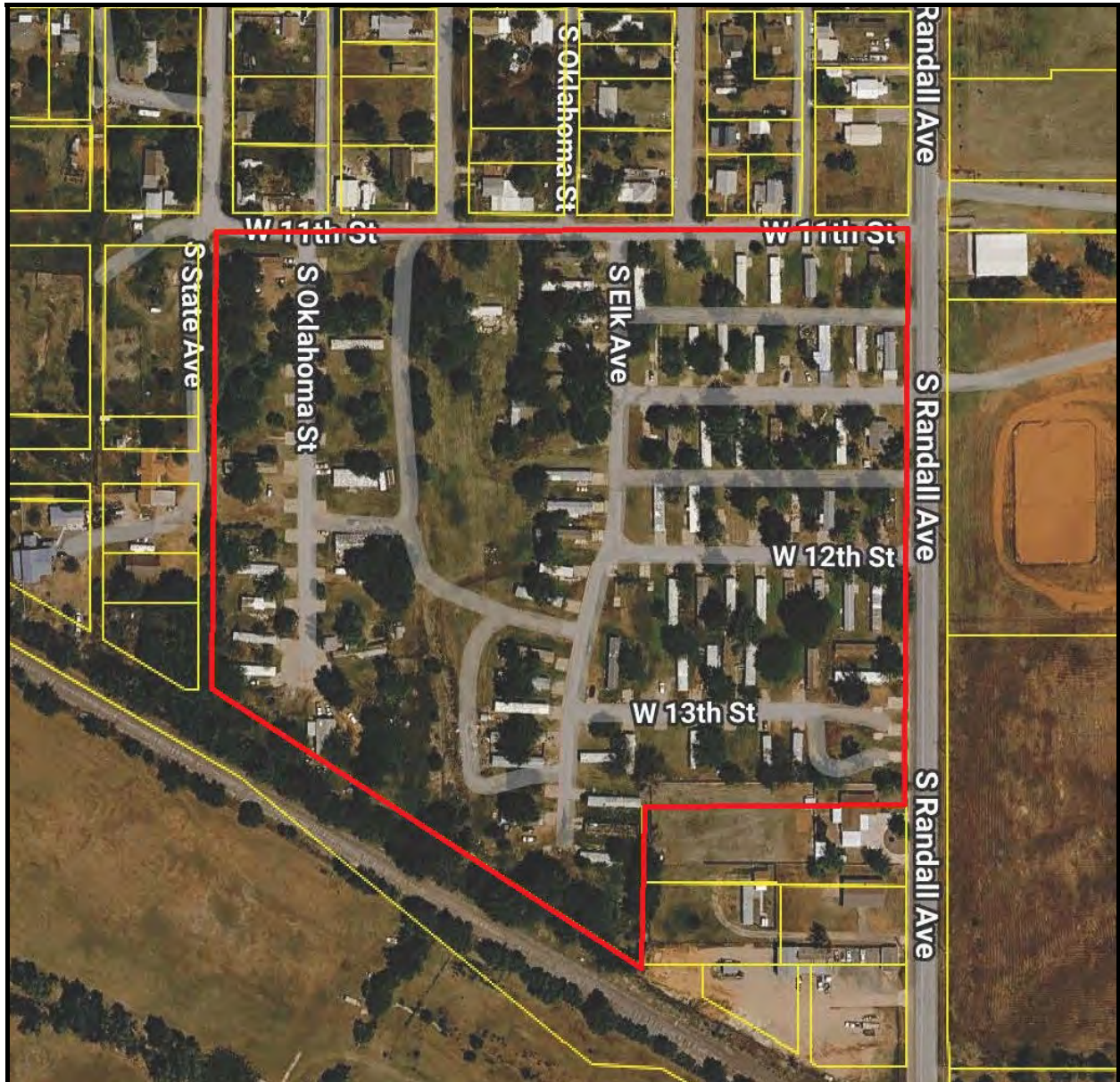


Figure 2 Site Aerial Photograph
